What do you value about the Kemnay LLCP?

- I have only attended one meeting but good attendance.
- Partnership working.
- Networking with other professionals and local people.

- Awareness raising / knowledge of other partners

How well do we share skills, information, knowledge and experiences across the Kemnay LLCP?

- Partners appear to share skills, information and knowledge.
- Quite well.
- I think we share our knowledge very well.
- From speaking to my team that attends, this seems to be a big positive in being part of the partnership.
- I think we share it well, everyone gets the opportunity to feedback at meetings on ongoing projects/areas of work. Information is circulated around the partnership group as and when necessary so I guess we do share a lot of what is going on with each other.
- Sometimes a lack of information e.g. litter picking duplicate event
- Should encourage more involvement of the partners in the agenda, have 'services update' as a standing agenda item

How well do we (as partners) actively seek out, promote and respond to partnerships that lead to better outcomes for individuals, groups and communities?

- Not sure due to lack of attendance.
- There is a good willingness to work together but does not always work out due to staffing pressures and it is difficult for the volunteer organisations to fit in with this.
- I think Partnership working is very effective.
- I think this does happen through positive locality relationships - not sure about how actively partners are seeking out, promoting and responding to partnerships. I am delighted to see the strengthening families work being so positively received and valued in Kemnay.
- I think this is an area that perhaps everyone finds quite challenging. With the ever-revolving workload, remits, etc, it's sometimes difficult to fully commit or follow through with certain things. In saying that however, from my point of view, I think we are trying to do this more and make more positive outcomes from the partnership workings.
- Depends on the strength of the individual partner.
- Agreed that through partnerships can achieve better outcomes.

How would you like to see Kemnay LLCP develop over the next year?

- Link with more partnership forums already in existence.
- To become more recognised in the local community and seen as a worthwhile partnership that can make a difference.
- I think the shared ethos of working for the whole community should continue.

- I would like to see learner involvement to inform and influence provision available locally. I would also like to see the meetings take place in the evening so there are no clashes and there is an opportunity to attend for those who struggle during work/school hours.
- I guess maybe just try to promote the LLCP as much as possible within the surrounding local communities, be this through more events and joint workings with schools, or latch on to more community events to promote the partnership group.
- Evening meetings were suggested to encourage learner involvement, but some thought this may discourage partners from attending.
- Attend parent open evenings / induction events.
- Increase effectiveness of promotion by adding text to flyers and linking it into events.
