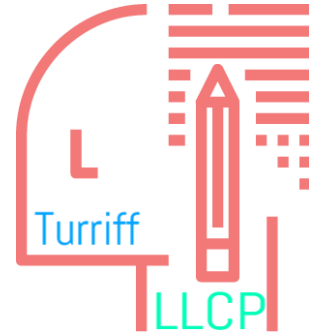

#### LLA/Active Schools

- LLA (as whole) are taking a phased approach to reopening facilities.
- Turriff Sports Centre was in phase 1 and whilst not confirmed yet, we hope to reopen the pool in the next month or so.
- Many adaptations have taken place in sites to ensure they are safe and protect staff and customers, this impacts on our ability to deliver everything we did in the past and is allowing us to look at new and different ways of delivering the service in communities.
- Initial attendance to the sports centre has been slow, but very positive responses received. I expect this to pick up as we move towards winter months.
- Booking must be done online, this is an area which has caused some difficulty but we are evolving our communications and contact helplines to support this.
