The Men's Shed is operational again.

The Mearns Healthy Living Network are back preparing planters to brighten the railway station.

Portlethen Academy

New leadership team after the summer, Neil and Tom are retiring. Barry Drennan will be the new head teacher.

Deputy head teachers Jenifer Law and Rhona Mackenzie will join the leadership team.

School roll continues to rise, hence there is fifth house Elsick. New guidance teacher joins the academy next term.

Young people are all set to come back in August after having dealt with a difficult term post lockdown -dealing with SQA assessments etc and the mitigations of masks, hand washing and access restrictions etc..

Neil expressed appreciation for partners present and they thanked him for his commitment over the last nine years.

With regards drugs in the school, SLT always work with police but there is no increase. He is aware that there are concerns in the south side of the city.
